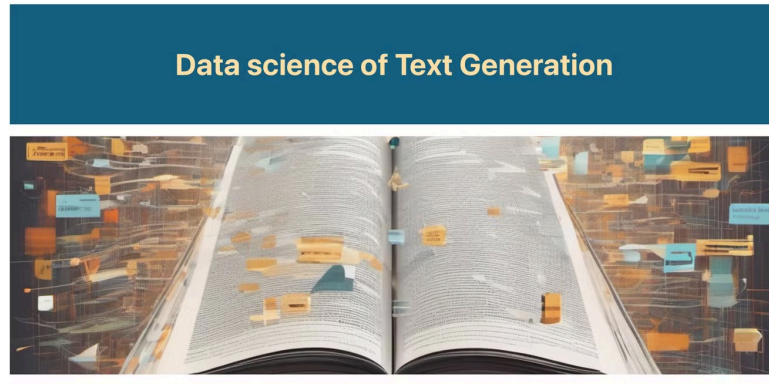


# Tutorial Guide: How to Follow Along

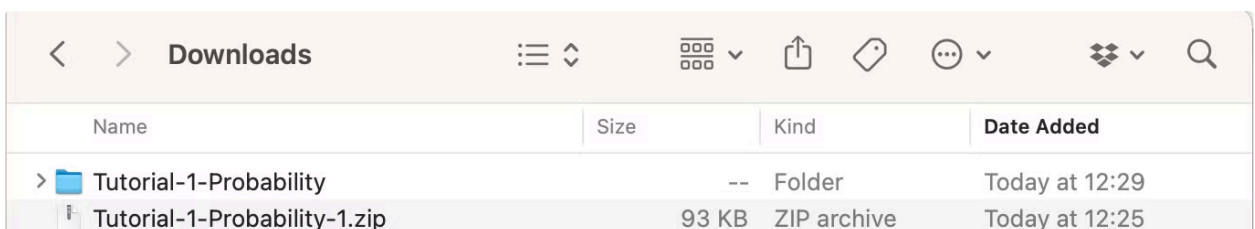
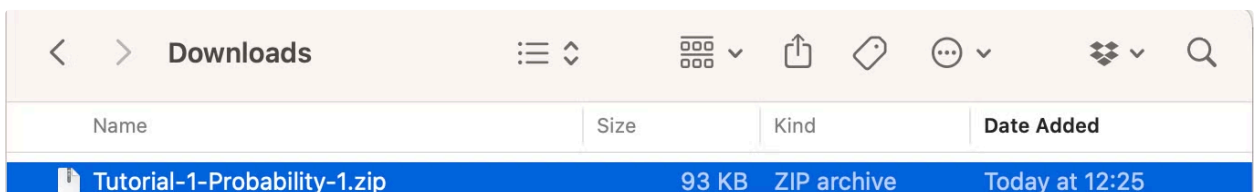
2. Download the folder of the tutorial of interest:

3. Unzip the folder so that you can view the individual files inside. If you are using a Mac, just double click on the folder in your downloads.



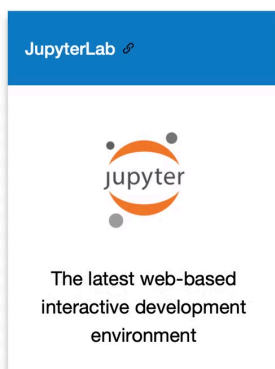

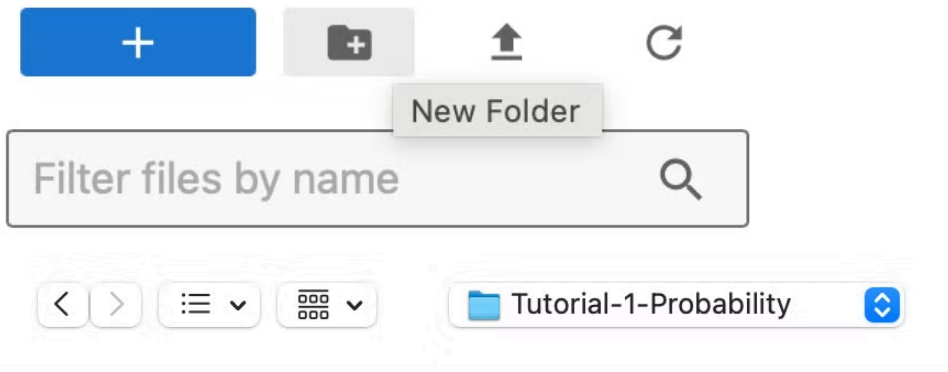
3. Search for "Jupyter notebook" and select on "Try Jupyter":

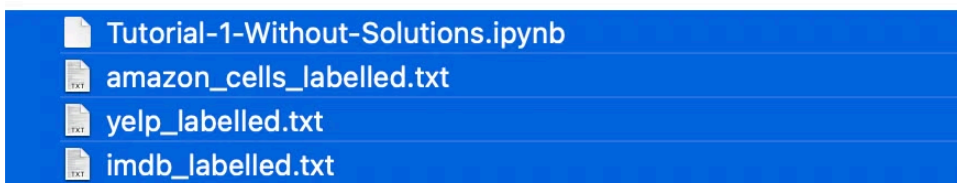
5. Select "JupyterLab":



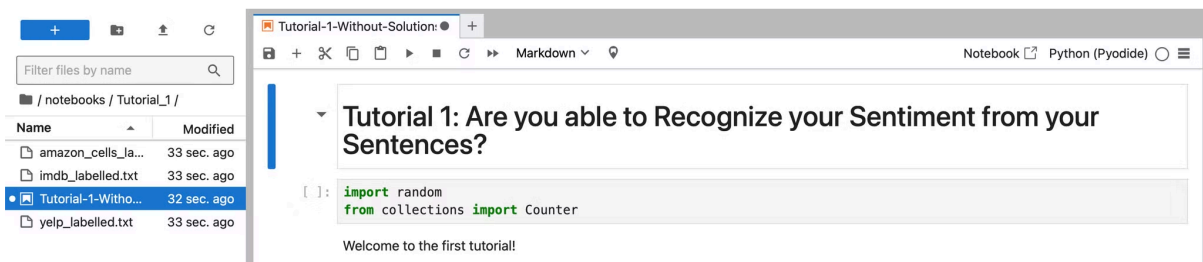
6. Create a new folder and upload the materials contained in the downloaded Tutorial folder.
